Student Rep

During my time at university I held the position of student representative for my course year. The role entailed me being a middle man between students and staff, leading up any student complaints and being responsible for ensuring the students on my course were not suffering in silence. As part of the role there were six annual faculty meetings to attend, covering a range of agendas, from the restructuring of courses and the units they offer to investigation of anomalous student feedback and results. In the third year I also took up the role of student rep for the computing and multimedia (CAM) department, requiring my attendance to personal meetings with department heads and other faculty meetings for the various other sides of the CAM department that I would otherwise not have been involved with.

At Locayta I was mainly responsible for maintaining the websites for one of the company's biggest contracts, BT. The sites maintained for BT were the direct enquiries site and the 118500 site. To begin with this meant learning the code layout for each of the websites so that simple text based updates could be performed, moving onto writing C# methods for the SMS logging and Captcha systems. In addition to BT responsibilities I was also on a two man team developing the new company website. Development of the company website included integrating the site with the bespoke CMS, a fair amount of javascript for the dynamic navigation menus, and a file upload and emailer system. Aside from the actual development Locayta also gave me experience in the form of fortnightly company meetings, where I would be asked to update the rest of the company on the progress of my current projects. Other meetings held included brainstorming sessions for the design of the company website, in which I made a number of suggestions that were incorporated into the final design.

In recent summers I have worked for the university, working for the Guildhall Halls (student halls), which open up like a hotel over the summer.
